

# Marking Scheme for Dialogue-Reordering

## Marking Scheme to be employed for evaluating Re-ordering of Dialogues as per CBSE

- Any logical progression of dialogue should be considered.
- Any two sentences wrongly placed, ½ mark to be deducted.
- Any two related and linked sentences wrongly positioned to be given 1 mark.
- 1 mark to be given for an appropriate beginning or ending.

### General Instructions for Section B

1. The Marking Scheme carries only Guidelines and does not constitute the complete answer. The students can have their own expression and marks should be awarded according to the child's originality or creativity.
2. Writing less or more than word limit given should not lead to deduction of marks.
3. 1 mark to be deducted for 10 errors according to CBSE guidelines.
4. A minimum of 6 out of 10 and 3 out of 5 must be awarded for the child's effort to express himself / herself in French.
5. Full marks to be awarded for any deserving answer in section B.
  - i) In case a child attempts both parts in a choice question, the better answer may be considered since this is a foreign language paper.
  - ii) In case a child crosses out both the parts of a choice question, the first option may be read and awarded marks.
6. IMP NOTE : Misinterpretation of the question should not lead to the student losing marks for format, creativity and grammar.
